Judges are to select horses whose way of going would be most suitable to hounds. Primary consideration should be given to even hunting pace, manners, way of going and style of jumping. Ticks will not be scored unless the fault of bad jumping. Conformation will not be considered. Horses in this division must be registered with AQHA, APHA, ApHC, PHBA, PtHA. **Very Low Hopeful Hunters may not have previously competed over fences over 2'6"**

## MISCELLANEOUS DIVISION SECTION I - OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

### USEYELLOWENTRYBLANK

Horses shall be of any breed or combination of breeds and serviceably sound. All pleasure classes are to be shown at a walk, jog, or trot, and lope or canter both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. To be judged on performance, manners, and conformation. **Any Horse and/or Rider may enter Opportunity Classes. USEF Membership is not required. Horses are not required to pay the USEF Fee. Any Horses and Riders in these classes who may be competing in other USEF classes at this show will be subject to membership requirements and the USEF fees in those classes.**

### NYS FAIR OPPORTUNITY HUNTER PLEASURE EQUITATION

Open to riders of all ages. Beginner riders may never have won a blue ribbon in another equitation class. Intermediate riders may not have won twelve blue ribbons in equitation classes. Classes won on the flat do not effect status over fences. Walk-Trot riders are not eligible for any classes requiring entries to canter. To be shown in hunter tack and attire.
