## Frequently Asked Questions for NY State Fair

### Why do I need to give my social security #?

The State Fair is the one who will be issuing the checks should you place. They won't issue them without a social security number. If you don't feel comfortable listing your # on the form, that's fine. But, the day of the show you will need to provide that info. If you forget, and place, you will not get paid. This will be your responsibility as NBHA NY 06 will not chase you down.

### How can I qualify for the Coliseum run?

The folks who have already qualified (Via NYS Horse Council) are automatically entered (but still need to pay the entry fee, which will be \$20 plus a \$5 timer fee). The rest of the entries come from the open NBHA barrel race. We "invite" the top ten (10) riders from each division to go to the coliseum. If a rider chooses not to go, then we will "bump down" to the next rider until all 10 spots are filled from each division. This run is not a NBHA sanctioned run. If you think you might have placed in the top 10 for your division and want to run in the coliseum, please do not leave the horse area. We will have the results from the open race as soon as possible and will call off the names of people that have qualified. We will make 3 calls for you to come and decide to run at the coliseum. If you are not present we will bump past you.

### What do I need to do when I arrive at the fairgrounds?

Please see enclosed map for additional info. All horse trailers should enter through Gate 7. At the gate you will receive an admission ticket (for each rider) and trailer tag for the grounds (RV tag as well if you have a RV spot). You will then go to the vet check (you will need to have Rabies and Coggins papers and for out of state horses-a health certificate). The vet will give you a form showing your horse(s) have been checked. You will need to bring that form to the office when you check in. After you park, you should come to the office and check in. We will have a list of stalls showing where your horses will go. At that time we can answer any questions or concerns you have, or take any late entries. The office will be open on Friday 8/22 from 6 pm – 10 pm and Saturday morning starting at 7 am. ### What time will stalls be available Friday night, and when do I have to be out on Sunday?

There is a show on Friday and other horses will be using the stalls. They are "supposed" to be out by 6pm. It doesn't always work out that way and there is no guarantee your stall will be clean. On Friday when I get there, I'll see who is still there, when they're leaving, and then I label stalls. I will have a stall list with me and there will be one posted at the office. Horses should be out of the stalls by 9am Sunday morning. You do not need to clean your stalls, but it is appreciated.

### More info on stalls.

Every horse is required to have a stall at the fair. This is the fair's rule. If you do not pre-enter, there is no guarantee that you will have a stall. If you decide to late enter and get to the fair and there are no stalls available, we will not be able to enter you. If you are unable to pre-enter, please call me (Aimee A-607-343-1188) and I will tell you if stalls are still left and you can reserve one at that time. Last year our stalls sold out so please be aware of this.

Also, if you are coming in to the Fair on Friday, but are leaving on Saturday, you'll pay for 1 stall per horse. Check the "Friday" line on the entry form so we know when you are arriving. If you come on Saturday and leave on Saturday, you will check the "Saturday" line and pay for 1 stall per horse. If you come on Saturday and stay over and leave Sunday, check the "Saturday" line and you pay for 1 stall per horse. If you come on Friday and stay until Sunday, check BOTH lines and you will pay for 2 days per horse.

### What do I need to bring?

- All horses on the fairgrounds are required to have a stall. These stalls are not pre-bedded (but might have "leftovers" from the prior occupant). You should bring your own bedding or you can purchase it at the fairgrounds.
- Rabies vaccination within 1 year, and coggins within 2007 or 2008 for NY horses and within 1 year of entry into NY for out of state horses. Your horse will not be allowed on the grounds without them.
- Health Certificate for out of state horses
- NBHA Card. We need to verify membership.
